



3 key areas of decentralised spending that need to be proactively managed The benefits of being proactive

In large organisations, there are two broad categories of spending: centralised and decentralised. While centralised spending is often predictable and easy to forecast, decentralised spending is a much tougher proposition. So where does decentralised spending occur and how do you identify it?

Decentralised spending usually happens ad hoc, as and when it is needed, and often outside of central procurement processes (centralised spending). This can lead to a lack of visibility and control, making it essential for finance teams to proactively manage decentralised expenditure.



This guide outlines three key areas of decentralised spending: unpredictable team spending, planned team spending and nomadic employee spending – and offers practical strategies for managing them effectively with Soldo's spend management platform.

Unpredictable Team Spending

Must-happen expenses to get the job done

Unpredictable team spend refers to the ad-hoc purchases that teams must make to complete their tasks. These expenditures are often necessary but difficult to forecast, making them a challenge for finance teams. For example, a marketing team might need to purchase last-minute advertising space to capitalise on an unexpected opportunity, or an IT team might require additional software licences due to sudden project demands.



How to proactively manage it

1. Set clear spending limits

Establish clear guidelines and spending limits for each team. This ensures that while teams have the autonomy to make necessary purchases, they stay within a controlled budget.

2. Real-time tracking tools

Soldo helps you introduce automation at each step of the process to eliminate manual chasing by sending automated reminders to attach receipts and compile information.




Unpredictable team spending example

A product development team may need to purchase new testing equipment when a prototype encounters unforeseen issues. By having a preapproved budget and clear communication channels, expenses can be managed without disrupting your overall financial plan.

Planned Team Spending

Sits outside of structured procurement processes

Planned team spend includes purchases that are anticipated and necessary but do not fit neatly within a structured procurement process. These might involve recurring costs, like subscriptions to industry journals, specialised training for team members or supplies unique to a particular project.



How to proactively manage it

1. Empower employees with the power to spend

Develop policies that accommodate the unique needs of different departments while maintaining overall financial oversight. The goal is to give every employee the autonomy to spend as needed. Set clear parameters and predefined limits.

2. Grant access with granular control

3. Easily capture receipts

Nomadic employee spend refers to travel and entertainment (T&E) expenses incurred by employees on the move, such as sales representatives or executives. These expenses can quickly add up and are often spread across numerous small transactions, making them challenging to track.
